Optum does not consider COVID-19 testing a requirement for a return-to-office strategy



Masking, physical distancing, proper hygiene, and isolation are primary protection measures



Testing is appropriate in certain circumstances, such as work environments where:



Virus exposure is prevalent

Contact with high-risk individuals is prevalent

Community infections are high or increasing



PHYSICAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE

Negative test required for employee to enter facility

Screenings include daily telephonic pre-screening and temperature checks



ON-SITE TESTING AND SCREENING

Testing count: 4–8K employees/week Regions: New York, California, Georgia Workplace environment: Entertainment production Risk of exposure: High



Ad hoc testing for employees who have been in contact with a diagnosed individual within 14 days

REASON FOR TESTING:

PHYSICAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE AND COMMUNITY INFECTIONS ARE HIGH OR INCREASING






Real-time data provided to employer from Optum data platform
